Eligibility

The Rose Hills Foundation Scholarships will be awarded to meritorious graduate student who meets the following criteria:

- Are pursuing a graduate degree (PhD, Masters or co-Terminal Masters) in the life or natural sciences, or engineering
- Are U.S. Citizens
- Whose permanent address is in Southern California and reside South of the Tehachapi Mountains
- Only students with University cumulative grade point averages of 3.5 or higher should be considered

Nomination Process

Graduate Division has provided GPS a list of Engineering eligible scholars, GPS will follow-up with each department with their list of eligible scholars. *If you do not receive an email from your department confirming your eligibility, unfortunately, you are NOT eligible for this fellowship*

Nominations should include:

- Brief justification from the department for the nomination
- The student's CV
- Student's initial report (maximum 2 pages) stating:
 - O Why did you choose this school?
 - O What are your career goals or post-graduation plans?
 - List any noteworthy achievements, scholarships/fellowships secured, including names of your published works and/or links to those publications.
 - If you had an opportunity to tell the donor what your scholarship means to you, what would you say?
 - Please tell us about your extracurricular or outside interests.
 - Please describe your area of focus and the aims of your current research (if applicable).

Selection

The School Fellowship Committee will review and select candidates. SSoE has **one** additional fellowship for the 2023-24 academic year.
